## Debian Squeeze Apache/PHP/MySQL/ProFTPD build

Installing Apache+PHP+MySQL+proftpd on Debian

- 1. Login to server as root. Run "aptitude install dselect" from command line. Wait for install to complete.
- 2. Type "dselect" in command line and press enter.
- 3. Go down to (S)elect on the menu and press enter. Either read the help file or press space to exit help.
- 4. Press '/' to do a search, and type in "apache2" and press Enter. Keep pressing 'n' on your keyboard until you see apache2 on the list, then press '+' to add to install queue, then press enter to go back to the package list. Do the same for each of the following packages "libapache2-mod-php5, php5, php5-mysql, mysql-client, mysql-server, proftpd-basic." Press enter when you are done to return to the main menu, select (I)nstall, and press enter. Your packages will be installed.
- 5. When prompted, type 'newpassword' for the mysql root password, then when prompted select standalone for proftpd.
- 6. Select 'Y' when prompted to remove .deb files.
- 7. (Q)uit dselect when you return to the main menu, and the install is complete.
- 8. From the command line type 'a2enmod ssl' to turn on SSL.
- 9. The location of configuration files for apache is under /etc/apache2, for php under /etc/php5/apache2/php.ini.
